



AFFIDAVIT OF ASSISTANT

If an applicant for voter registration cannot write, s/he may make a “mark” in the space for the signature. However, if an applicant due to disability is unable to either sign or mark the voter registration form, the Affidavit of Assistant Form must be provided by the person who assists the applicant with registering. The assistant could be a BOEE worker or someone of the applicant’s choosing – a friend, family member or caretaker.

The Affidavit of Assistant Form, whenever used, must be included with the Mail-In Voter Registration Application that will be forwarded to the Board of Elections and Ethics. Please feel free to reproduce this form, as necessary.
